ANNUAL PESTICIDE USE NOTIFICATION**

Cedarburg School District utilized an integrated Pest Management (IPM) approach for killing insects, rodents and weeds. Our IPM approach focuses on making the building and grounds an unfavorable habitat for these pests by removing food and water sources and eliminating their hiding and breeding places. WE accomplish this through routine cleaning and maintenance. We monitor the building and grounds to detect any pests that are present.

Chemical pesticides are used only when necessary to eliminate a pest problem. The school district strives to use EPA approved, tested and least toxic productions when possible.

We will provide notification of specific pesticide use to any member of our faculty, staff, student or parent who requests this notification.
